Students develop new charity to support homeless...

Year 13 students Areej Nadeem, Maryan Omar and Syeda Shah have the passion to set something up that can potentially make a change to society.

Restoring Trust is their idea to create a charity that will support homeless people more specifically women on the streets. Their research has unearthed a need for sanitary items by women on the street, a product seen as a luxury item by many organisations meaning free supply of these to homeless women is limited.

The three inspirational students plan to have separate careers in Law, Radiography and Mechanical Engineering while coming together to run this ambitious charity. In five years they want Restoring Trust to grow nationally in order to help different demographics including children and sexually abused people all suffering the horror of being homeless.

Areej, Maryan and Syeda all met here at UTC Bolton which we are incredibly proud of. Restoring Trust charity will hold its first fundraising event on Women's Day, 8th March 2018 with details to be released on our website nearer the time. We wish them luck as they continue this venture.
